Reading: This week we will continue working on character traits. The classes plan to have a test on their novel and character traits on Thursday, 4/19.

Spelling: We will test Thursday on words that end in –less or –ness.

Grammar: For the first part of the week we will continue working on possessives. We will have a test on possessive nouns and pronouns on Wednesday, 4/18. The students have completed a few worksheets, and should also study RN 118, 119, and 125. This is a difficult concept for the students. Please review with your child.

Writing: We will continue writing a personal narrative with dialogue.

Math: We will test Wednesday on the first half of Chapter 8. It focuses on fractions. This is a concept with which the students don't have a lot of experience. Please continue to go over homework with your child. We

will also have another timed multiplication quiz on Wednesday. There are not any retakes this quarter.

Social Studies: We will test on Chapter 9 on Friday. Students have a study guide and it is online. It focuses on Michigan's economy. In addition, I am sure your child has mentioned that we will be doing a project in class on a Michigan product. Some of the students have volunteered to bring in a Michigan food product for the class to sample while we listen to the presentations. This is in no way a requirement, and I have asked any students that volunteered to clear it with you first.

Science: We are working on Chapter 3, which focuses on plants. We planted sunflowers on Friday, and we are anxious to watch them grow!

Religion: We will have a test Tuesday on Chapter 9. It focuses on the Church as the Body of Christ.
