Reading: This week we will be working on drawing conclusions.

Math: We will finish Chapter 4. We are tentatively planning a test for 11/15. Please have your child practice facts daily. We will also continue our timed quizzes this week on Wednesday. The next one will be a 0-3 mixed practice quiz.

Religion: This week we will work on Chapter 6. It focuses on praying always. The students will learn about different forms of prayer.

Grammar:

This week we will continue working on commas. We will then learn about simple and compound sentences. We will probably be ready for a Grammar test early next week.

Writing: This week we will begin writing personal essays. The students will state an opinion and then tell a story from their lives that supports that opinion.

Science: We will begin Chapter 6 which focuses on weather. We will create a water cycle diagram on our seesaw app. We will also do a water cycle experiment.

Social Studies: We will begin lesson 2 of Chapter 3 which focuses on the French and Indian War. We plan to have a vocab quiz on lessons 1 and 2 on Friday, 11/10.

Spelling: The spelling test will be Thursday, 11/9. It will be words with the "ow" sound like in town.
