Date: October 30th to November 3rd

Reading:

This week we will finish text features and begin working on drawing conclusions.

Math:

This week we will finish Chapter 4 and test on Thursday, 11/2. The students should all be practice multiplication facts every day for at least 5 or 10 minutes. They will need to memorize all their facts. Our timed quizzes focus on one number, but the chapter is asking them to work on all facts. We will also quiz on three's this week.

Spelling:

We will have a test Thursday, November 2nd. The words will be posted online, and they are in your child's Reader's Notebook. I asked all the children to bring the Reader's Notebook home because they didn't all have time to write the words in the planner. Our test will be on words that have unexpected spellings. This usually means they contain a letter or letters that are silent.

Writing:

Most students are done with their narratives. We will finish up, and share with our classmates. We will then begin writing personal essays.

Grammar:

This week we will finish verb tenses and begin working on commas. This will include commas in a series and commas in addresses.

Religion:

We will have an open book test on Chapter 5 on Monday. We will begin working on Chapter 6 which is about prayer.

<u>Science:</u> This week we will finish Chapter 5<mark>. We will test on Friday on</mark> just lessons three and four. The study guide went home in the Friday Folder.

Social Studies:

This week we will begin Chapter 3, which is about the arrival of the Europeans.
