Reading:

This week we will begin to work on identifying story structure. We will apply what we learned about character traits to help develop our writing.

Math:

Our first Math test will be Thursday, 9/14. It will cover lessons 1.1-1.7.

These lessons are all about estimating, mental math strategies, and addition. Please review at home.

Spelling:

We will have a test Thursday, September 14th. The words will be posted online, and they are in your child's Reader's Notebook. Our words are long vowel words with the VCe pattern. We have decided to call the lists B and C instead of A and B. Sorry for the confusion. List B will be the basic words. List C will be the challenge words.

Writing:

We will continue working on our personal narratives this week. Our focus will be on describing characters and setting and creating a clear sequence of events.

Grammar:

This week we will finish working on subjects and predicates, fragments, capitalization and end punctuation.

We will have a quiz on Wednesday, 9/13.

Religion: We will focus on finishing Chapter 2 this week. It is about the Church as a community. There will be not be a formal test on this unit. We will have a final project instead.

Science: This week we will be working on Chapter 1. This chapter focuses on force and motion.
